

Spring Show at A Gallery Of Arts In Claremore

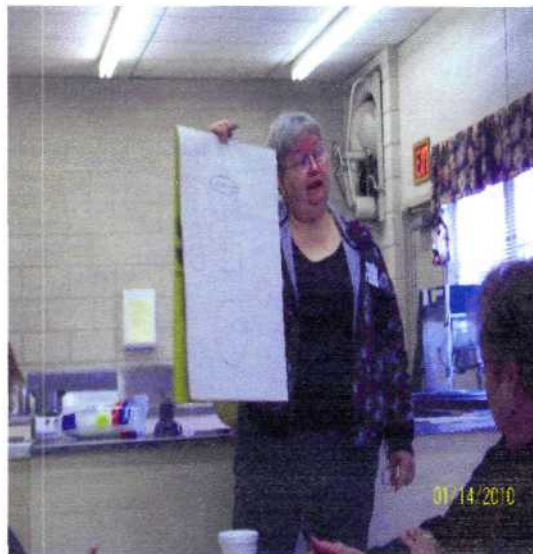
The GCWS Annual Spring will be at A Gallery of Arts, 510 W. Will Rogers Blvd. Claremore, Ok. The show begins on Mar. 3rd and will hang through Mar. 26th, 2010. The show this year is a miniature show with no paintings over 10"x10" and no smaller than 2"x2". The frame size will be no larger than 16" in any direction. The criteria for the show will be aqueous medium on watercolor paper. All paintings entered must be for sale with thirty percent of the sale going to the gallery. In turn the owner of the gallery, John Wolf, will donate 10% back to the GCWS

scholarship fund. The show is a juried show but there will be no winning placements or prizes. You may enter up to three paintings. The fee to enter up to three paintings is \$10.00. The Juror for this year's show is Gary Moeller. Some important dates to remember: Feb. 11th...Entry forms and \$10.00 fee due. (This is the date of our Feb. GCWS general meeting.) Mar. 2nd...Deliver yur paintings to A Gallery of Arts. Last name A-L deliver from 10 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. Last name M - Z deliver from 10:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Mar. 3rd... Opening day of the show.

Mar. 13th... Reception at A Gallery of Arts from 2 p.m. until 4 p.m.
Mar. 26th...Pick up your paintings at A Gallery of Arts from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
Those not having paintings juried into the show will have the option of you coming back for your paintings or allowing them to be returned to you at the March GCWS general meeting on March 11th.
