Broken Arrow Historical Society Show Set For July

The plans for the Broken Arrow Historical Society Art Show have been finalized. The show will hang at the Museum from July 1st through July 30th, 2010. This will not be a juried show and all paintings entered that meet the requirements of entry will be hung. Entrants must be a member in good standing and they may enter three paintings. A ten dollar fee is required at the time of entry. Paintings may be for sale and all sales will be the responsibility of the member. All paintings entered will hang for the duration of the sale. Requirements of Entry are as follows.

Water media on paper.
No mat requirements.
25% collage accepted.
Image must be at least 10"x10" up to 22"x30".
Subject matter must be original work.
Frame no larger than 48" in any direction.
Wooden frames must have full dust covers. Metal frames must have foam or mat board.
Painting must be equipped with a wire hanger.
The painting, the mat and the frame must be clean, inside and out.
There must be a label on the back upper left hand corner.
Entries must be dropped off at

the museum on June 30th from 10 to 11 a.m. Show opens on July 1st and closes on July 30th. Paintings need to be picked up on July 30th from 1 to 2 p.m. There will be no reception for this Show.
