He was not able to attend the reception but did give a quick critique on each painting to Dale Treeman to

share with the Artists at the reception. Gary was impressed with all the paintings and said that each painting had a good quality that made it special. He gave five suggestions to Dale on how to make a successful painting to share with the group.

1. Use the white of the paper for your whites.
2. Use unexpected splashes of color.
3. Use subject matter appropriate

to the size of the paper.

4. Let gravity work for you.

5. Proportion your signature to the size of the painting.

The reception, held on March 13th, was well attended with thirty visitors signing the guest book and many visitors not signing the book.

Visitors signed up to win a door prize. The lucky winner was local resident and beginner watercolor artist, Judy Ordal. She won the Thumb Box by Guerrilla Paints.
